



## ENTRY INFORMATION SHEET FOR HORDLE GARDENING CLUB CLOSED SHOW

We are holding our 25th "Closed Show" on Friday 26th July 2019.

To help you get started, we have put together some descriptions of how the vegetable and fruit classes should be displayed.

All exhibits must be free of any damage or disease

CLASS Vegetables/Fruit		Description of presentation
1	Lettuce, any variety	Display with roots, but they must be washed.
2	Courgettes, 3 any variety	Well matched, must be no more than 200mm long. With fresh flowers attached where possible.
3	Potatoes, 3 any variety	Clean (wash with a sponge) and well matched in size. Rose end (eyes) facing upwards.
4	Onions, 6 salad	Display roots, but they must be washed. Trim roots to make them even.
5	Radish, 6 one variety	Clean (wash with a sponge) and well matched in size. Trim foliage to 30mm and keep fine tap root intact. Display in a circle with foliage facing inwards.
6	Onions, 3 one variety	Well matched in size. Cut neck to 4 inches and bend in half. Tie tops with raffia, or similar. Arrange on rings or fine sand.
7	Shallots, 5 one variety	Well matched in size. Tie tops with raffia, or similar. Arrange on rings or fine sand.
8	Collection of 4 individual vegetables.	
9	Culinary herbs cut	3 stems of 3 separate varieties.
10	Beetroot, 2 any variety	Clean, and well match in size. Trim foliage to 75mm and leave main root (washed).
11	Runner beans, 6 one variety	Long uniform straight shape, leaving stork and heel.
12	Broad beans, 6 one variety	Shapely with no bulges. Stage in a row with tail end facing the front of the bench.
13	Carrots, 3 one variety	Foliage trimmed to about 75mm, clean, well matched in size.
14	Rhubarb, 3 sticks	Cut foliage to about 75mm, trim end of stick to a point. Clean and well matched in size.
15	Any vegetable not listed above.	
16	Cucumber, 2 one variety	Clean, and well match in size.
17	Tomatoes, 4 of one variety	Stage on a plate with calyces uppermost. Well matched in size and shape.
18	Plate of 10 soft fruit, one variety.	Arrange in a circle with stalks facing out, stalks and hulls must be attached
19	Plate of 5 stoned fruit, one variety.	Arrange in a circle with stalks facing out, stalks and hulls must be attached
20	Plate of 3 varieties of soft fruit, a minimum of 5 each variety.	Arrange in a circle with stalks facing out, stalks and hulls must be attached
21	Any fruit not listed above
